

HMS Cavalier is Britain's sole remaining wartime destroyer. Preserved in The Historic Dockyard, Chatham, she acts as a permanent memorial to more than 11,000 men who lost their lives in the 142 Royal Navy destroyers that were sunk during WWII. One of 96 Emergency Programme destroyers that were ordered between 1940 and 1942, *Cavalier* was built by J Samuel White & Co on the Isle of Wight. Her action packed naval career included the perilous Arctic Convoys of WWII, bombarding dissident Indonesian nationalists, quelling a mutiny in the Royal Indian Navy, supporting the hydrogen bomb tests on Christmas Island and becoming the fastest ship in the fleet.

Containing more than 200 specially commissioned photographs, the book takes the reader on a superbly illustrated tour of the ship, from bow to stern and deck by deck. Significant parts of the vessel – for example, the gun mountings and the open bridge – are given detailed coverage both in words and pictures, so that the reader has at hand the most complete visual record and explanation of the ship that exists.
